
















USED PRICES KEEP MOVING HIGHER


MY 2018 Retail and Wholesale Price Index

COX AUTOMOTIVE LEADING INDICATORS

- Leads in June through Sunday on **Autotrader** were down 4% y/y and on **Kelley Blue Book** were down 3%; compared to 2019, both were up, but leads have slowed in June
- **Dealertrack** unique credit applications on same-store basis were down 9% y/y and against 2019 last week, but the weekly trend improved
- **Xtime** saw a 5% decline y/y last week in consumers having their cars serviced; against 2019, appointments completed were down 19%, but comparisons were impacted by Memorial Day
